Summary of key findings



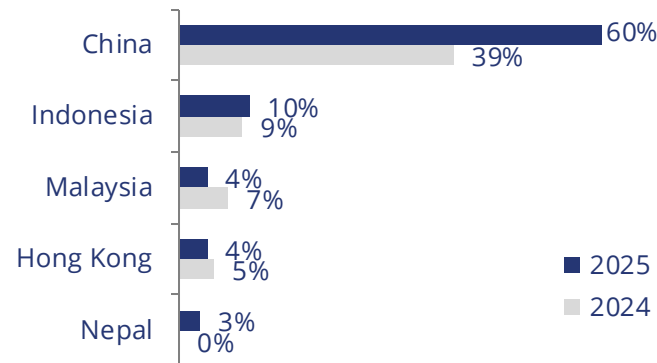

- The UWA College student experience KPIs remain very positive – and most have improved vs. 2024
- Feeling welcomed and helping students adapt to the education system were seen as key strengths, however, scores were less positive on value for money and feeling connected to the wider university
- Satisfaction was high for most aspects of the learning experience – particularly so for students from China and for those on diploma programmes (most learning scores have improved vs. 2024)
- Perceptions of the campus, local area, and safety, remain strong positives for the College and it's important that we use these in our promotional messaging
- The areas where scores were lower were student accommodation (cost and internet access), living costs and eating options (and whilst scores have improved, they are typically lower for non-Chinese students)
- Our student support areas remain a key strength with all achieving satisfaction scores over 90%

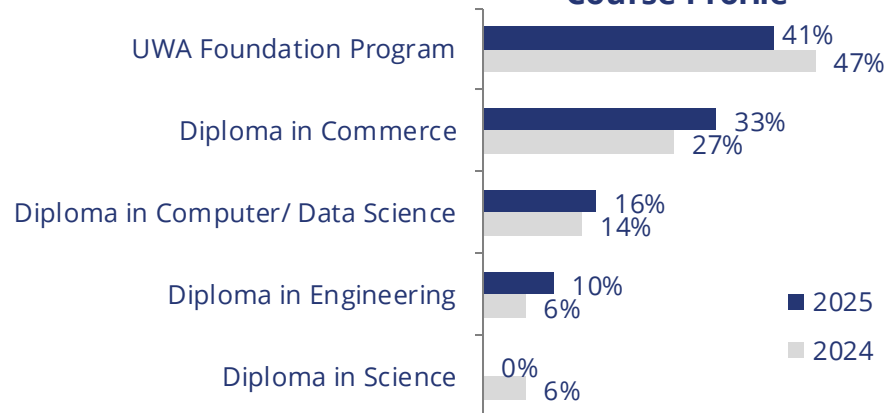

Nationality Profile (Top 5)

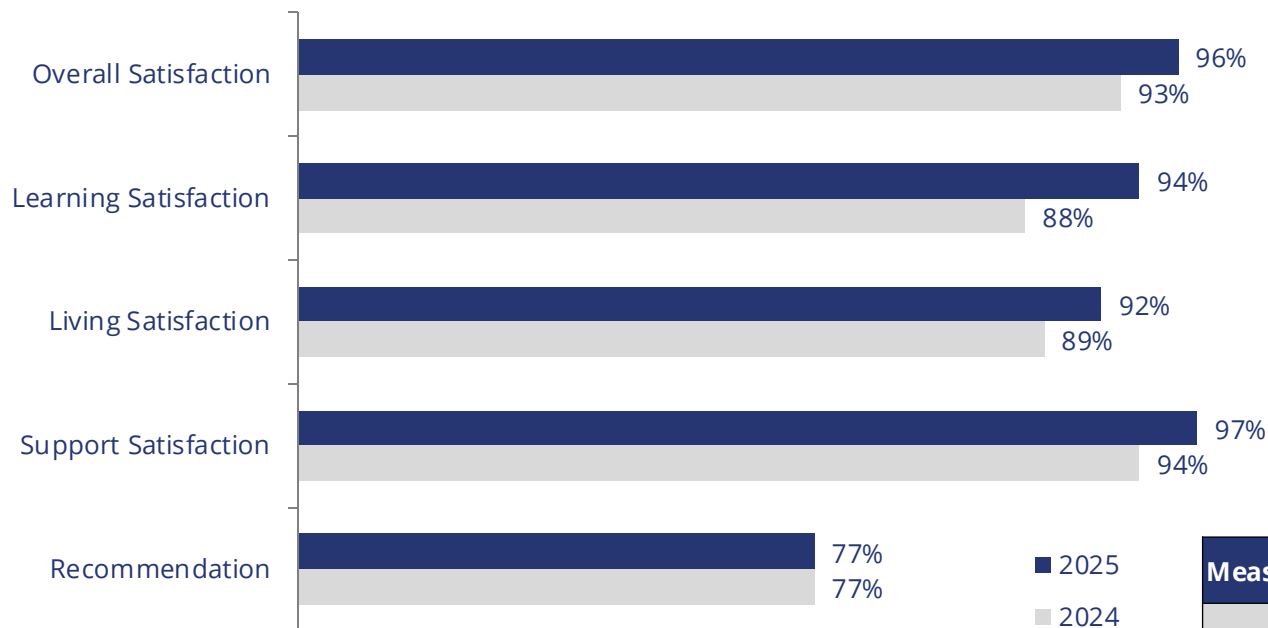

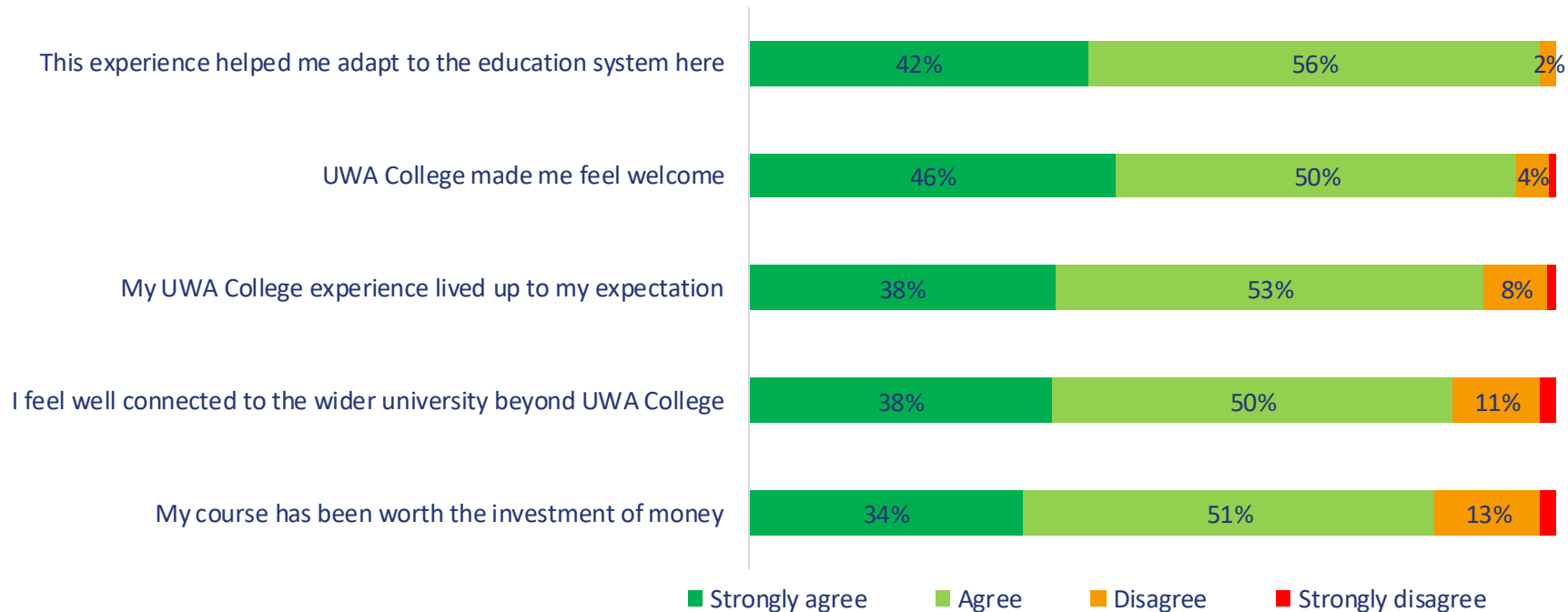
Our KPIs have improved in most student experience areas Vs. 2024

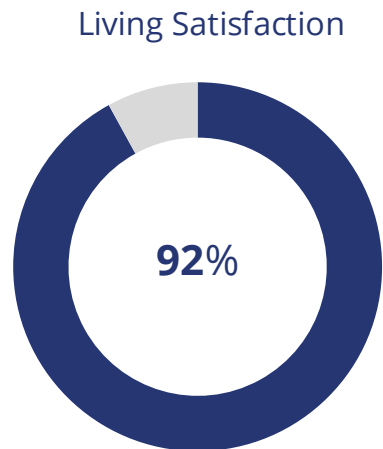
Feeling welcomed and helping students adapt were seen as key strengths, perceptions were less positive around worth the investment of money



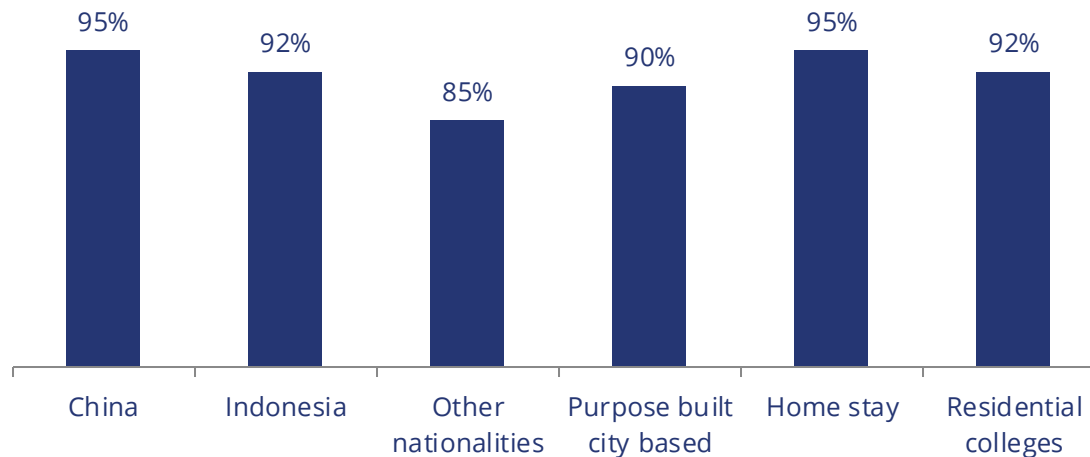
How much do you agree or disagree with the following statements:

Overall living satisfaction was also high for most groups of students



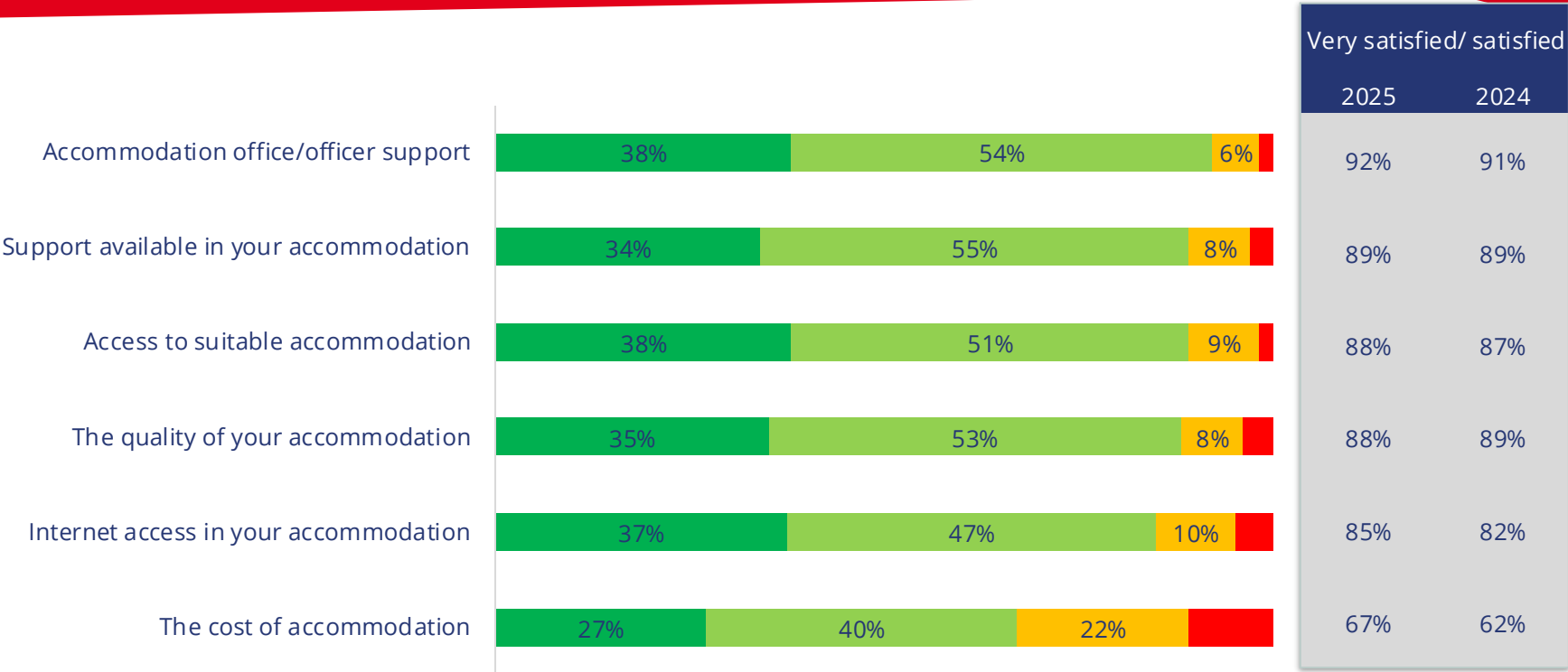
Living Satisfaction (by student group)

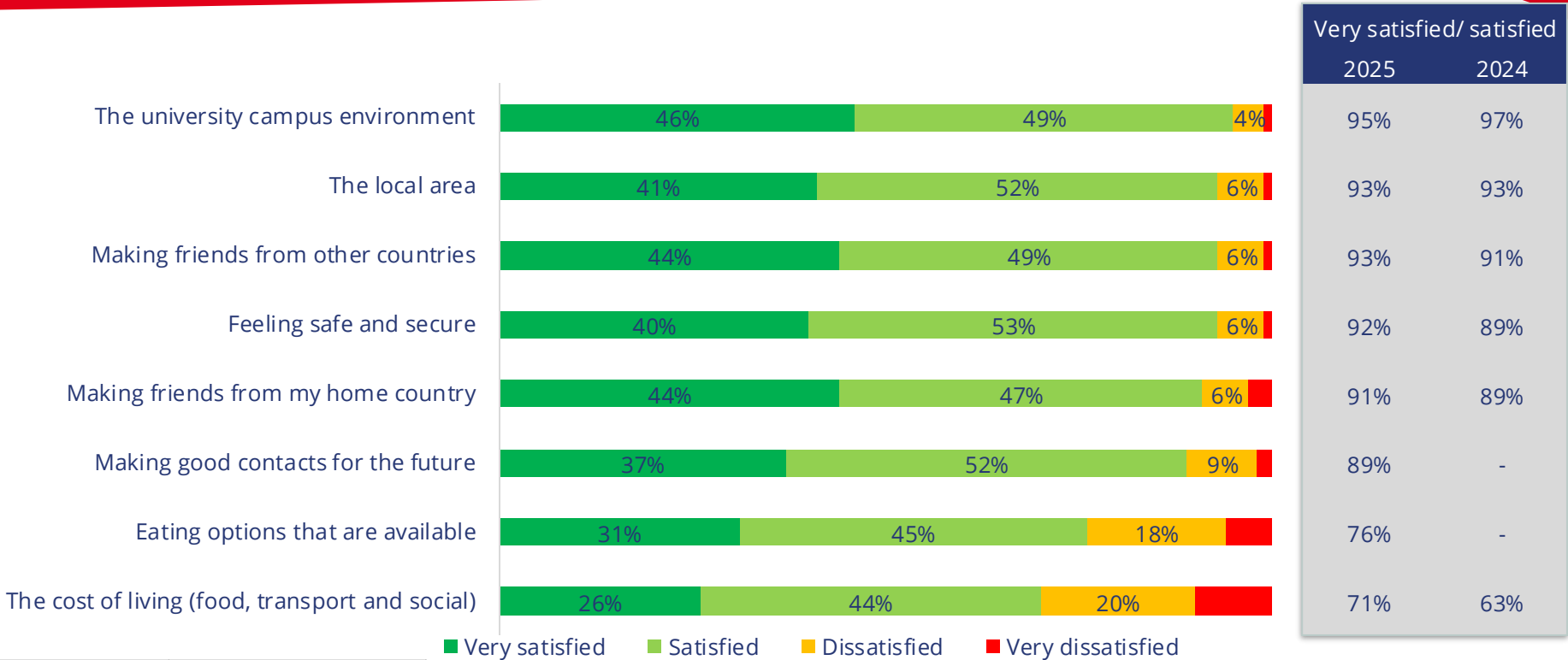
"People are friendly and I feel safe most of the time, but the rent is increasing and eating out is expensive"
